YOUR ITINERARY 3 DAYS, 2 NIGHTS ON THE WILD SIDE

DAY 1: AMPITHEATRE 9KM

- Elevation Gain: 489m
- Difficulty: Moderate (some coastal rock scrambling, short steep climb via ferrata)
- Highlights: Nelson's Bay Cave, pristine rock pools, Jurassic-period Amphitheatre, sea arch, and undisturbed sandstone fynbos.
- Camp: Nestled in a quiet coastal cove with nearby tidal rock pools.

11km DAY 2: RONDEBOSSIE

- Elevation Gain: 742m
- Difficulty: Moderate to difficult (minimal coastal rock scrambling, loose rocky sections)
- Highlights: Rondebossie Neusgate, forested sections, coastal cliffs, Oumatjie bay with arches and caves, Fynbos Nature Reserve, Afromontane forest.
- · Camp: Set up near the coast or in a sheltered forested area at Cairnbrogie.

DAY 3: CROOKS CROSSING 11km

- Elevation Gain: 499m
- Difficulty: Difficult (50% loose or scrambling coastal rocky sections)
- Highlights: Cairnbrogie Coastal Corridor, ancient Milkwood, Crooks River, Kranshoek hiking trail, dramatic bays, Harkerville viewing site.
- End: Shuttle returns to Plettenberg Bay.

Leave your phone behind and immerse yourself in nature. Our guides will take photos of your group throughout the hike, allowing you to truly experience the surroundings without distractions.
